Reminders

Packed Lunches

- Lots of children are bringing in their lunch in a carrier bag. Children who bring a lunch from home must bring their lunch in a sealed container. The weather is now becoming warmer unsealed food is attracting ants on the lunch trolley.
- Packed Lunches MUST be brought into school in the mornings when the children arrive to school. **Packed lunches that are brought to the office (without pre-arrangement) may be refused.**

Home Dinners

- Children who choose to go home for dinner must be collected by a named responsible adult from the School Office and dropped back by an adult at 1.05pm. This is to ensure safety of all the children during the lunch hour.

Medical Appointments

- Please try your best to organise routine appointments for your child for before / after school and in the holidays. Children should not be taken out of school because their parent has an appointment to attend.

If your child has a hospital appointment or urgent doctor/dentist appointment and this appointment falls during the lunch hour, please collect your child prior to the lunch hour starting – the Office staff **will not** be able to get a child if it is during the lunch hour.

Lunch hours are as follows:

Years Reception, 1, 2 & 3 – 12.00pm – 1.10pm

Years 4, 5 & 6 – 12.15pm-1.10pm

Children returning after their appointments during lunch time will not be able to join their class until the end of lunch, 1.10pm.

Breakfast Club/ Morning Clubs

- To ensure the safety of children in school, children attending Breakfast Club/ Morning Clubs must not arrive before 8.00am as they **are not supervised before this time; please ensure your child is accompanied until the club starts.**
- Children arriving after 8.20am, unfortunately will be not able to join the clubs.
