A car went across on the red light so please remain extremely vigilant at all times. Thankfully, the children were not badly hurt but they were, of course, very shocked and upset.

We have been very disappointed by the number of families requesting leave during term time. Holidays will not be authorised and you may have to pay a fine if you take your child(ren) out of school. Our current attendance is 94.4% which is well below the expected standard. We are due a visit from Ofsted this year and the poor attendance will count against us. More importantly, children rarely catch up on lessons they miss and this affects their learning, progress and attainment for the rest of their time at school.
